



## Tahiti Fête of San Jose July 11 & 12, 2015

You are invited to participate in the annual Tahiti Fête of San Jose. The two-day program will be held at the San Jose State University Event Center on Saturday and Sunday, July 11&12, 2015. At this point we still have a few food booths available.

We are interested in working with you to provide quality local foods during these two days. Booths will be limited with a variety of foods offered for the participants. To provide an opportunity for you to earn more revenues, we are also permitting all food vendors to sell sodas and water. All similar drinks sold by vendors should be the same price. Water should be sold at \$1.00 each.

Attached is a Food Vendor Application Form, which should be returned to me no later than June 15, 2015. All applications will be approved on a first-come, first-served basis as we seek to balance the variety of foods. The fee is \$1,000.00 for two days, which includes one table and 2 chairs. You need to provide your own health-approved food booth. You can also bring extra tables.

Health Permits are not included. The permit fee is \$186 for the food booths and \$99 for the indoor packaged food vendors. Please fill out the Health Department permit form and our Booth Application and mail it to me ASAP. You can make out one check for both the booth fee & the health permit to: PuaTahiti Productions. I will pick up the Health Permits for all the food vendors. The permits will be given to you when you set up your booth.

All food booths will be located at both entrances of the Event Center. As in previous years, there will be a steady flow of people outside. Someone needs to be at the booth at all times since people are constantly by the food booths, and not just during lunchtime. Please indicate if you wish to serve food to the volunteers at a special rate of \$5.00 a plate. You cannot charge an additional charge to the volunteers for the plate lunch. We will issue food coupons to the volunteers and I will reimburse you in cash either daily or all together on Sunday, July 12th.

# Tahiti Fête of San Jose 2015

## FOOD BOOTH REQUIREMENTS

- **Set-up time** is on Friday, July 10th while we are decorating the Event Center from 10:00 am to 4:00 pm. If you cannot come on Friday, please be prepared to set up early Saturday morning, July 11th. Use only your assigned booth. Please do not block the sides of the tent space so each vendor can have access to their space. If you have valuable items to store inside the Event Center, you can do so, otherwise cover up your equipment. You can also set up the tent and table on Friday and bring the food and equipment early Saturday morning.
  
- Do not barbeque inside the tent, only outside in the back area of the tent.
- \* We will provide a nearby area with tables and chairs for people to sit and eat.
- \* Bring your own extension cords. Electricity will be provided, however, for the shave ice vendor, it is recommended that you bring in a small generator.
- \* We encouraged booth operators to decorate booths in a Polynesian manner and to display organization or restaurant banners in front of the booth. Please provide a sign or banner with the name of your booth to place outside your tent.
- \* The booth fee is \$1,000. for the 2-day weekend. You must provide your own food-booth tents. Health permits are not included. If you are a restaurant and have a health permit, send a copy to me. You must bring the permit with you and staple it on the front of the booth. For those ordering a temporary permit, we will be obtaining them 5 weeks before the Fête. The Health Department requires that we as organizers of the Fête, obtain all the food permits. The fee is \$186 and \$99 for packaged food booths
- \* I recommend you sell sodas and water at \$1.00 each. Check with the other vendors so all are selling them at the same price.
- We have had vendors raising their prices from the price listed on the application. This will not be permitted. List your prices in visible sight, do not raise the prices once established.
- \* Please send in the names of the operators of your booth. NO CHILDREN UNDER 14 will be allowed in the booths, especially babies. This is a health regulation. You will be allowed access to the Event Center to use the bathroom. Wear your vendor badges so security will let you in.
  
- **Very Important!** The Health Inspector advised that you must have Clorox and measuring bleach sticks to test to see if the water used is sanitized. The Health Inspector will be monitoring every booth so make sure you are in compliance. The new inspector is very critical. Do not offer the inspector any food, be professional and courteous!
  
- Remember to comply with health regulations, inspectors will check your booth for compliance. Certificates must be placed your outside your booth. If you have a permanent health certificate for food vendors, you must display the certificate in full view outside your booth. See the attached information files from the Health Department.
  
- We ask food vendors (not shave ice or coffee) to please offer volunteers a special plate lunch rate of \$5.00 each. We will supply the coupons (they do not pay) and I will reimburse you for the lunches on either daily or on the last day, Sunday, July 12th. If you wish to kokua (help) with this, please indicate it on your application so we can advise our volunteers as to the booths participating this program.
